It's now official—the chamber has a new website! Please make sure that

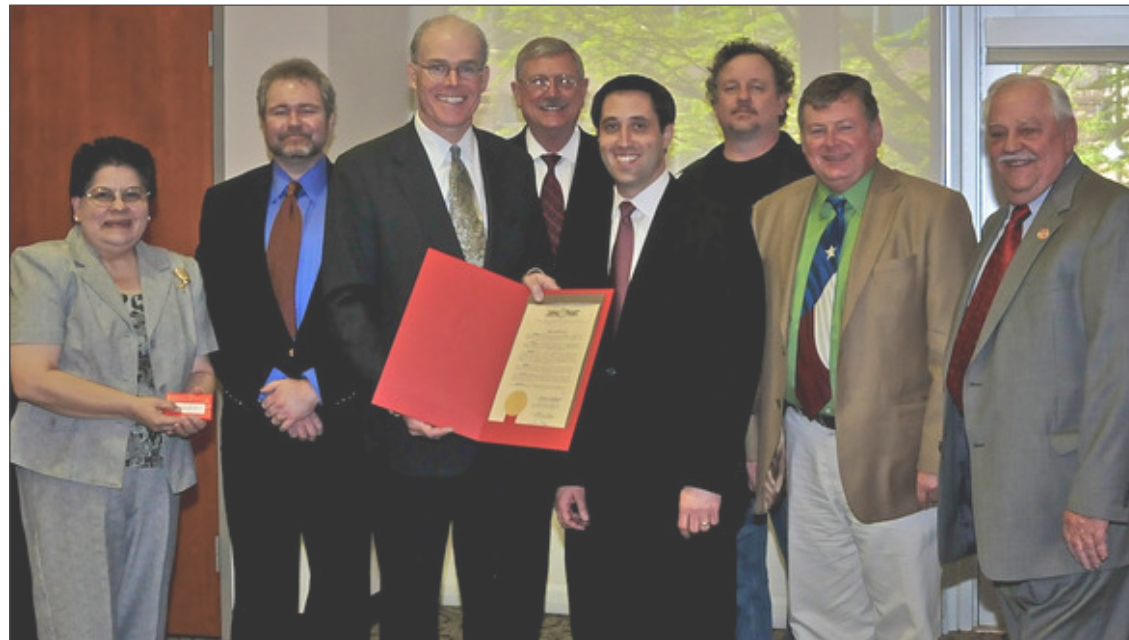

Houston Executive Airport breaks Ground on a new corporate FBO hangar

BROOKSHIRE -- (May 4, 2009) – Houston Executive Airport (KTME) announced plans to build a new Corporate FBO Hangar. The construction of the 23,400- square-foot hangar comes amid high demand for aviation facilities on the West side of Houston said airport owner and developer, Ron Henriksen .

“The airport’s prime location along Houston’s energy corridor continues to play a role in drawing new clients who are seeking an alternative to Houston’s crowded airports,” said Henriksen. “Our robust business is an indicator that General Aviation is thriving here in Houston.”

Located near Houston’s energy corridor, Houston Executive Airport is a private commercial development established by a former commercial pilot and Houston businessman, Ron Henriksen . The airport caters to business and general aviation aircraft. With an eye for

coming growth, Henriksen has long-range plans for the airport’s runway to be extended from 6,610 feet to 7,604 feet to accommodate larger jet aircraft.

Airport Executive Director Andrew Perry , A.A.E., said the tremendous growth experienced in the Houston area furthers the need for additional hangar space.

“Houston Executive Airport was built specifically to meet the needs of corporate travelers to Houston,” said Perry. “Since we opened our first hangar in 2008, it was clear that we were filling a real need in the aviation community. We are very pleased to be able to help our fellow pilots with an unbeatable aviation option.”

As part of Henriksen Jet Center, the 23,400-square-foot hangar will be large enough to house up to 20 corporate aircraft. Perry said Henriksen Jet Center is a Chevron fuel dealer that provides

services such as aircraft 24-hour fueling, ground handling operations, rental cars and other amenities.

“Our mission is to provide first-class service and amenities to pilots and passengers flying into Houston,” said Perry. “Our understanding of that level of service is rooted in decades of combined aviation experience.”

Houston Executive Airport is a private commercial development established by a former commercial pilot and Houston native, Ron Henriksen .
